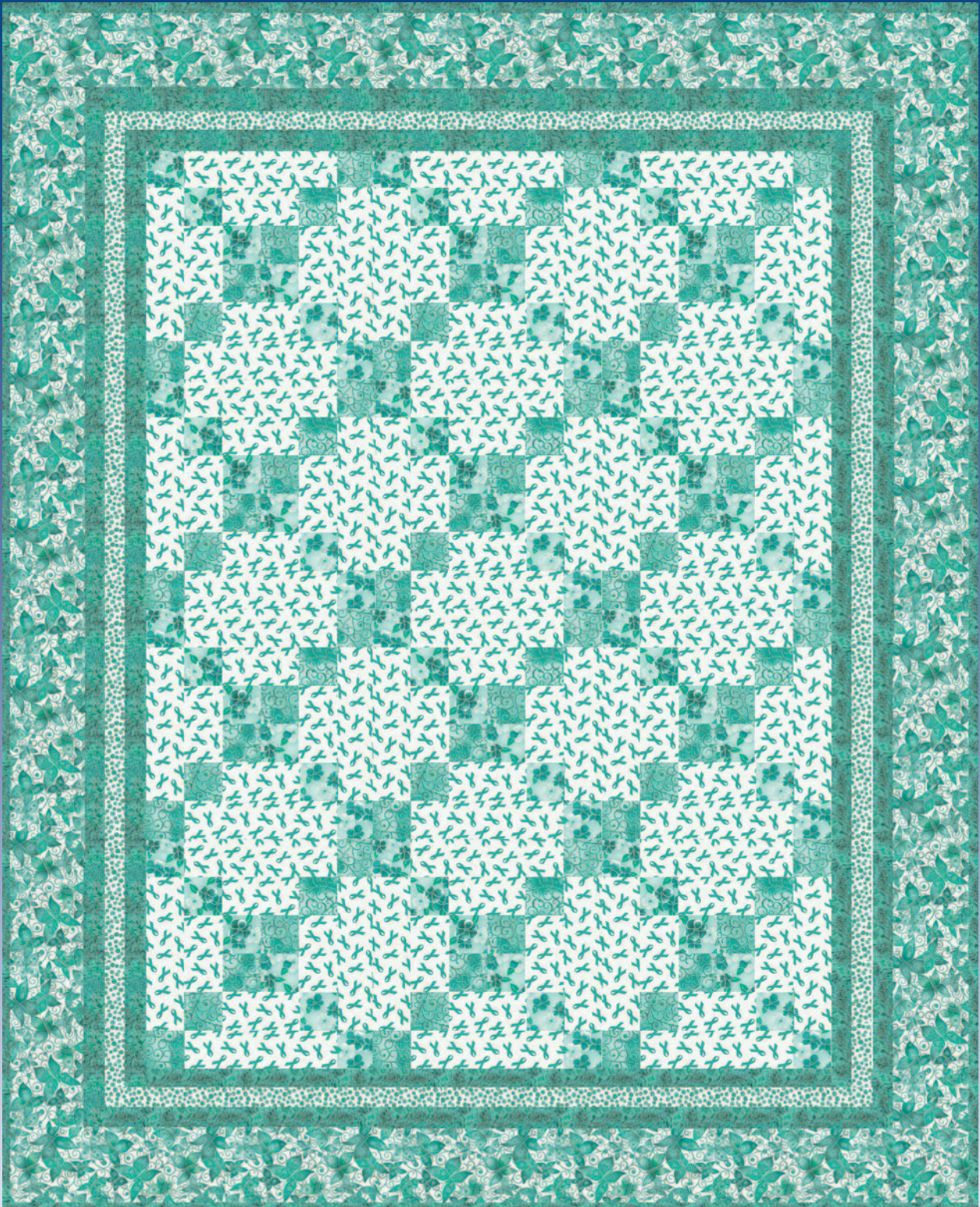

All Seam allowances are 1/4". Please read all directions before beginning and press carefully step-by-step. Border measurements are approximate, always measure your quilt top before cutting border lengths.

### Fabric Requirements:

Fabric A: BTR-4177 Ivory	1-1/2 yard
Fabric B: BTR-M3792 Jade	5/8 yard
Fabric C: BTR-M3791 Jade	5/8 yard
Fabric D: BTR-M3795 Jade	1-1/4 yard
Fabric E: BTR-M3794 Ivory	1/2 yard
Fabric F: BTR-M3793 Ivory	1-1/4 yards
Backing: BTR-M3793 Ivory	3-1/2 yards

### Cutting Directions:

Cut forty-eight 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips and forty-eight 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips.  
 Cut seventy-two 2-1/2" squares.  
 Cut seventy-two 2-1/2" squares.  
 Cut two 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips.  
 Cut six 1-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece them together into two 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" and two 1-1/2" x 48-1/2"  
 Cut six 2-1/4" x WOF strips for the binding.  
 Cut two 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips. Cut three 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece them together into two 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips.  
 Cut six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece them together into two 4-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips and two 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips.  
 Piece into one 54" x 66" piece for the back.

### Assembly Instructions:

- Follow Figure 1 and sew together two 2-1/2" Fabric B squares and two 2-1/2" C squares into one checkerboard center.
- Sew one 2-1/2" Fabric B square to one end of one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A strip (fig. 2). Sew one 2-1/2" Fabric C square to the other end of the 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A strip (fig. 2).
- Sew one 2-1/2" Fabric B square to one end of one 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A strip (fig. 3). Sew one 2-1/2" Fabric C square to the other end of the 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A strip (fig. 3).
- Follow the block layout and sew the block together. Make twelve blocks total.
- Sew the quilt top together, three blocks in each row, four rows total.
- Sew one 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Sew one 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Sew one 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Sew one 4-1/2" x 54-1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

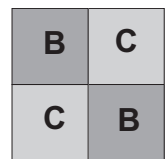


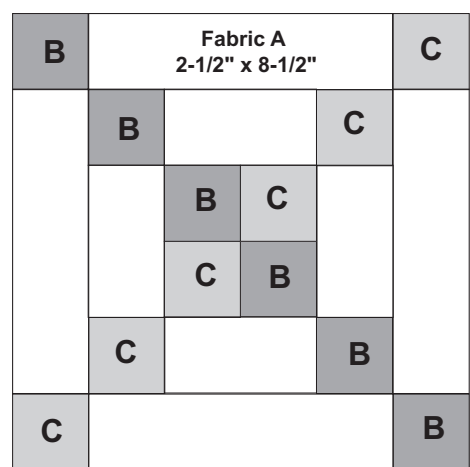
